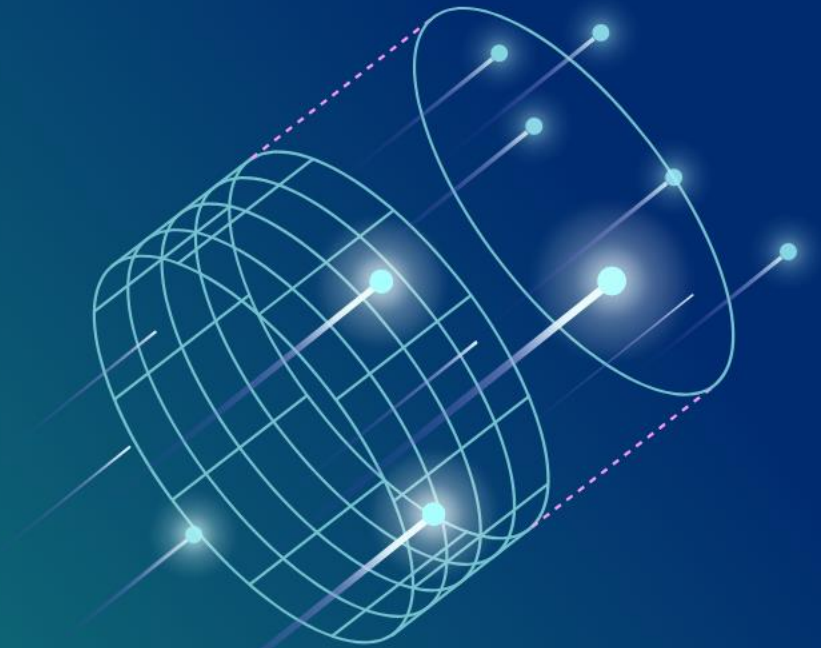

The Digital Sandbox supports firms at the early stages of development, providing access to synthetic and publicly available data to help them validate novel solutions.

For firms new to the market, access to consumer and market data is essential.

The Sandbox can offer General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) compliant data, as well as opportunities for collaboration to help enable experimentation.

First piloted in 2020, the Digital Sandbox has shown that collaboration between firms and regulators is essential for innovation.


There are four key features to a credible Digital Regulatory Sandboxes and AI Sandboxes that you should look for

Features

- Provide data sets and sandboxes for AI model building and testing
- Integrated technology to accelerate access to AI for start-ups and small businesses
- Increase industry collaboration to encourage legal and regulatory certainty
- Enable tests of the implementation of policy and common approaches
